We invite you to prepare together the 1st Students' Political Council. Many students today maintain a critical spirit, are dissatisfied with curriculums, want to do something for society: for environmental protection, for internationalism, against war and fascism. Criticism of capitalism is on the rise. But in the academic system, uncritical conformity and careerism are promoted. Crisis management and pragmatic „muddling through“ characterize the scene instead of profound education for the masses. Rising prices, high rents or marginal „Bafög“ increases - it cannot go on like this! We want to make a contribution to solving of humanity's problems. We are committed to the eradication of hunger, environmental protection or against the oppression of women. We are against war and armament. What do we do when today the existence of humanity is being threatened by a global environmental catastrophe or the threat of world war? It is necessary to take a well-founded and critical engagement with study contents and examination methods that flood us with details and obscure the social relations of capitalism. Scientifically grounded societal perspectives for the future are in demand. What do we want to study for and how? How to really change something? For this, there is a vital need for an exchange of experiences and consultation: Non-partisan, open-minded on an anti-fascist basis, financially independent and self-organized, democratic cooperation on an equal level and a culture of solidarity in disputes - these are well proven principles of other councils that we can learn from. To connect as students and academics with working people, the labour movement and to think beyond the existing capitalist society. Therefore, socialist perspectives must also be discussed objectively. Incompatible with this free thinking is fascism, racism, anti-Semitism, anti-commu-

nism and anti-scientism. We are calling upon you to prepare together with us such a council in 2./3. December 2023.
